Official Statement

WHEREAS, this year's annual observance of the National Day of Prayer will be held on May 1st, 2025; and

WHEREAS, a joint resolution of the United States Congress, signed into law by President Harry S. Truman in 1952, established an annual day for prayer; and

WHEREAS, the declaration was amended in 1988, by both Chambers of Congress and signed by President Ronald Reagan, setting the permanent date for the National Day of Prayer on the first Thursday of May each year; and

WHEREAS, on this day we reflect upon the freedom and prosperity enjoyed by both the State of Connecticut and our Nation; now

THEREFORE, I, Ned Lamont, Governor of the State of Connecticut, do hereby officially proclaim the day of Thursday May 1, 2025, to be

NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER

in the State of Connecticut.
