Our National Broadcast was hosted by Kathy Branzell and Reverend Samuel Rodriguez at the Museum of the Bible. Through our partnerships with Christian ministry and media leaders including Waterstone, Gloo, Pray.com, Daystar, God TV, NRB TV, CBN, Revelation TV, Bott Radio Network, Salem Communications, and many other national and local networks and stations, we reached into 195 countries with a call to fervent prayer and a clear presentation of the Gospel. This year we continued to expand the many ways that we can connect **NDP**365 and support our neighbors in prayer and beyond. Through our website, social media, national prayer calls, weekly newsletters, and texting, people are prayed for and kept up to date on how we can all pray, everyday.

Opportunities to Equip Leaders

In 2021, we were approached by the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities (CCCU) with the opportunity to develop a prayer curriculum for 185 seminaries, Bible colleges, and Christian colleges and universities. In 2023, God availed even more through a collaboration with the Global Church Network. The door is now open to provide prayer training and resources, equipping emerging **leaders** in our Christian schools, and equipping the pastors and ministry leaders serving in over 700,000 churches around the world today.


Text Your Prayer and Beyond


Developing our digital communication strategy has become increasingly important as a way of connecting with our coordinators and ministry partners. Statistics show that 81% of Americans text regularly and that they open 98% of all texts they receive – making texting **the most effective way to engage** in continuing conversation.

In 2023, God availed much by providing the texting tools that we are now using. Today, we not only communicate regularly with our coordinators and leadership, but use our texting platforms to **rally urgent prayer around important emerging issues** effecting our world. The most recent example is unified, day and night prayer for Israel as the war against Hamas rages on. By texting ISRAEL to 31401, God's people can opt in to receive two prayer prompts each day.

This year, God provided a partnership with Gloo, enabling our Task Force to receive prayer requests via text from anyone needing prayer, anytime, anywhere. Real time **notifications of a prayer need are texted to our team**, allowing us to respond immediately with prayer.

In 2024, we're working to expand our engagement on the Gloo platform to connect to people, partners, resources, and more – encouraging, equipping, and engaging more


